Stitching	It's important to check your stitching for rot, breakages or loose threads. Be sure to check every buckle and turn front and back.
Leather	Check the leather parts of your bridlework for wear and cracks, especially on martingale loops and where the leather turns around a buckle.
Buckles & Billets	Undo all of your buckles and billets to make sure they are all intact and functional. If any need replacing your local saddler will be able to replace these for you.
Padding	Check any padding you may have for creases, dents, lumps or ridges. These can cause areas of pressure against your horse.
